The UAPB Aquaculture/Fisheries Center offers a paid 10-week summer internship program in Aquaculture and Fisheries.

Interns will be selected on a competitive basis. Interns selected will be eligible to have their travel to Arkansas reimbursed. Applicants can apply to work in a variety of areas such as:

- Laboratory research in fish health and nutrition
- Pond and hatchery studies with catfish, baitfish and hybrid striped bass
- Experiential activities related to commercial aquaculture production of important commercial species
- Electrofishing
- Sampling of fish populations in large rivers and impoundments
- Aging techniques
- Creel surveys
- Other relevant projects

Participants will also develop a PowerPoint-based seminar to present to a group prior to the end of the internship. Interns will have the opportunity to shadow a professional in the field for a day, tour aquaculture facilities and visit unique environments and ecosystems. CAPLEDER is a paid internship that will start on June 1 and end on August 5.
