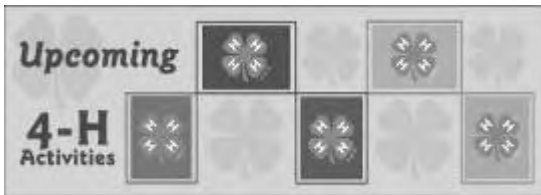

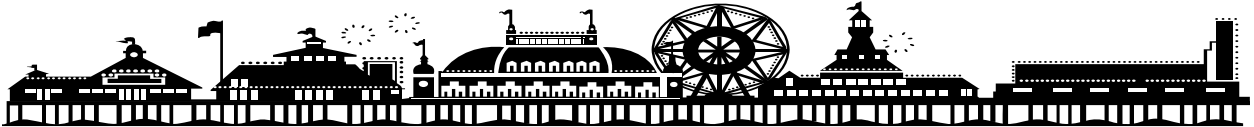


4-H Shooting Sports
