



Two Step Fire Ant Control Method

DO NOT DISTURB MOUND PRIOR TO TREATMENT

Step 1 – Broadcast application of bait product.

**Step 2 – Mound treatment of individual nuisance or problem mounds (use bait or contact insecticide).
Apply Step 2 one week AFTER applying Step 1.**

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Are conditions right to treat Fire Ants?

- Temperature between 70° and 90°F
- No rain expected within 12 hours
- Ants actively foraging (check with hot dog pieces)

Baits

- **hydramethylnon**
Amdro Fire Ant Bait Yard Treatment, Amdro Fire Ant Bait, Amdro Pro
- **indoxacarb**
Advion, Spectracide Fire Ant Killer Plus Preventer Bait Once & Done
- **(S)-methoprene**
Extinguish Professional Fire Ant Bait
- **(S)-methoprene and hydramethylnon**
Amdro FireStrike Fire Ant Bait, Extinguish Plus Fire Ant Bait
- **spinosad**
Ferti-lome Come and Get It, Green Light Fire Ant Control with Conserve, Safer Fire Ant Bait



Contact Insecticides

- **acephate**
Orthene 75% Turf Tree and Ornamental Spray (dust, wettable powder), Ortho Orthene Fire Ant Killer (dust), etc.
- **carbaryl**
Eliminator Lawn Insect Killer Granules, GardenTech Sevin Lawn Insect Granules, etc.
- **pyrethroids**
Various trade names
- **spinosad**
Green Light Spinosad Lawn and Garden Spray (liquid), etc.
