

Club Participation Award

An award will be presented each year to the club that obtains the highest participation score. The participation score will be determined by dividing the number of members who participated in each county activity by the number of enrollment cards each club has in the Extension office. The percentage will be based on the number of 4-H members in each division at each activity.

Club of the Year

This award will be chosen from the clubs that make the requirements for “County Honor Club.” The requirements will be more in-depth community service activities that show your club really makes a difference in the community.

Spirit of 4-H Award

An award will be given each year to a Junior member and a Senior member who consistently show a positive attitude and willingness to participate and who exert that “extra” effort “To Make the Best Better.”

Volunteer of the Year Award

This award will be presented each year to a dedicated leader who has gone above and beyond the required expectations. This award will be chosen by the Extension agents. Members and leaders may nominate a leader by filling out a nomination form.

State 4-H O-Rama

To encourage teen participation in State 4-H O-Rama, a gift will be presented to Senior 4-H members who compete in State O-Rama for the first time. Thereafter, they will receive certificates. First place winners at State O-Rama will receive a special gift at the Perry County 4-H Awards Banquet.

Teen Star and Ambassador

To encourage teen participation in the Teen Star and Ambassador programs, a gift will be presented to all first-time Teen Stars and Ambassadors. Thereafter, they will receive certificates.

4-H Member of the Year

The 4-H Member of the Year Award will be given to an outstanding Senior 4-H member and an outstanding Junior 4-H Member who have shown extraordinary leadership skills and promotional efforts. The recipient of the award will be chosen by Extension agents. APPLICATION CAN BE PICKED UP AT COUNTY EXTENSION OFFICE – IT IS REQUIRED. The winner will be recognized at the annual awards program banquet.
