Did you know that there is a Saline County Fair Pageant and Talent contest?

The Pageant & Talent Contest is Aug. 28, 2010 and will be held at the Harmony Grove School Auditorium, starting at 3 pm. Age groups are:

0-12 months	4 - 5 year olds	13-15 year olds
12-23 months	6-7 year olds	16-21 year olds
2 year olds	8-9 year olds	
3 year olds	10-12 year olds	

Age groups 1-12 are \$20 to enter and 13-21 are \$30 to enter. The talent contest is held the same time as the pageant and it is \$20 to enter.

Contestants may enter in the following categories: Vocal solo, Vocal group, Dance solo, Dance group and Variety. A winner will be awarded from each division and from those the overall winner will be chosen.
