Valentine Recipe: Heart Brownie Muffins

- 1 box brownie mix
- Water, vegetable oil and eggs as called for on the mix
- 1-2 tablespoons powdered sugar

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Place paper baking cups in 24 regular-size muffin cups. Spray with cooking spray. Make brownie batter as directed. Fill each cup with 2 tablespoons of batter. Bake 24-26 minutes and cool in pan for 20 minutes. Carefully remove paper from muffins; cool upside down about 15 minutes. Cut a small heart out of paper and place on top of brownie. Sprinkle brownie with powdered sugar and carefully remove the paper heart. Repeat on all brownies.


