## **Membership**

Section 1. The membership is open to all eligible persons regardless of race, color, national origin, religion, gender, age, disability, marital or veteran status, or any other legally protected status

a. An Extension Homemakers member is a member of an active Extension Homemakers Club; an EH Club is a structured organization with elected officers (President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and President-Elect), a regular meeting time, and a commitment to support the mission of the county and state organization and to participate in its educational and outreach function. The mission of the club shall correspond with the mission of the organization.

b. A Project EHC member is a member of a Project Extension Homemakers Club. The group may or may not be structured – there is a contact person, if no elected officers. The meeting times are not necessarily on a regular basis but rather at the discretion of the members of the Project EH Club. They agree to support the mission of the county and state organization and to participate in its education and outreach function where possible. The mission of the Project EH Club shall correspond with the mission of the organization. A Project EHC member is represented at county council meetings by a representative chosen by the Project Clubs.

c. An Extension Homemakers Member-at-Large is a membership category that may be adopted by a County Council. The membership classification is available to an individual in an area where an Extension Homemakers Club is not organized or where the individual cannot meet regularly with an organized club because of employment or other scheduled activities. An Extension Homemakers Member-at-Large is a member without vote.
