If you have any records of EHC in those early years, please bring in a copy.

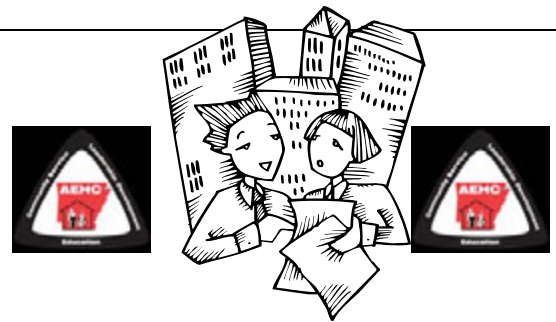
We will be discussing a giant celebration for EHC at our Board meeting on February 11.

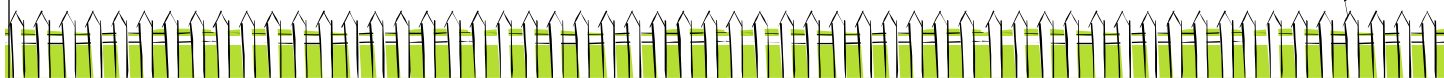

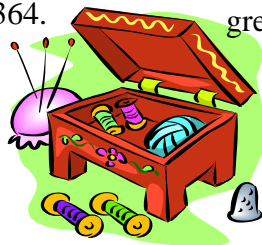
