Market-driven Aquaculture: Developing and Sustaining an Industry

A special session is being announced for the World Aquaculture Society meetings in San Antonio, Texas in 2007. This session will focus on research results related to economics and marketing in aquaculture that address market-oriented production systems and market feasibility assessment. Papers are being solicited on 1) economics and management issues of aquaculture production that target specific markets; 2) studies of market access, transactions costs, and feasibility; and 3) the four Ps of marketing applied to aquaculture products. All presenters are encouraged to submit a manuscript on their topic, which will be considered for publication in a Special Issue of the journal Aquaculture Economics and Management. Papers must be suitable for publication in Aquaculture Economics and Management and will be subject to the same review process and criteria as any other submission to this journal.

Paper titles are due by: **August 1st, 2006**
