6. What is the average number of club members that attended regular club meetings?
(Use eight of the most attended meetings to get the average)
7. Did your club conduct or participate in a community improvement or community service project?

8. How many club members participated in a club, fair, show window type exhibit, or a project tour?

9. Did you have a special club recognition dinner, in which members' achievements were recognized?

10. How many county 4-H activities did your club participate in?

11. Did you keep a record of your clubs meetings and activities?

12. How many club members completed project records?

13. How many news stories, radio programs, TV programs, or other public venues did your club use to promote 4-H?

14. How many new members were enrolled into your club this year?

15. Why does your club deserve this award?
