

4-H YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

Definition of Terms

BENCHMARKS

Non-duplicated – actual number of different individuals who participated or attended.

Record Book completed – the Arkansas Record Book Form, a story, and pictures were completed by the 4-H member and submitted for judging as a Record Book.

Project Book completed – the 4-H member completed the 4-H project book activities designated for the appropriate age level during the club year.

AUDIENCE

4-H Member – any youth who has completed individual enrollment in an organized ongoing local 4-H unit and is aware of his or her involvement in 4-H.

4-H Parent – any adult recognized by Extension as a 4-H'er parent or guardian.

4-H Volunteer – any adult or youth recognized by Extension as giving service to the 4-H program without salary or wages from Extension.

4-H Youth Participant – any youth taking part in programs provided as a result of action by extension personnel (professional, program assistant and volunteer).

Non-4-H Adult – any adult who works for the benefit of youth and/or is recorded by Extension as a participant in a 4-H sponsored adult learning experience. May include professionals of agencies and groups beyond 4-H.
