

## **Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (the Affordable Care Act)**

### **This notice is being provided as required:**

The University of Arkansas health plan believes its plan is a “grandfathered health plan” under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (the Affordable Care Act). As permitted by the Affordable Care Act, a grandfathered health plan can preserve certain basic health coverage that was already in effect when that law was enacted. Being a grandfathered health plan means that your coverage under the University of Arkansas health plan may not include certain consumer protections of the Affordable Care Act that apply to other plans, for example, the requirement for the provision of preventive health services without any cost sharing. **(Please note that the University of Arkansas health plan is in compliance with all preventive health service requirements and covers all preventive services at zero member copayment).** However, grandfathered health plans must comply with certain other consumer protections in the Affordable Care Act, for example, the elimination of lifetime limits on benefits.
