

# **“PEDAGOGY” vs “ANDRAGOGY”**

*Teacher Centered Learning* or *Student Centered Learning*  
**Learners...**

<b>Depend on teacher to decide what should be learned</b>	<b>Participate in deciding what should be learned</b>
<b>Accept content as reliable</b>	<b>Evaluate content’s validity based on beliefs and experiences</b>
<b>Long-term use</b>	<b>Immediate use</b>
<b>Little or no experience with little ability to serve as resource</b>	<b>Past experiences with ability to serve as a resource to others</b>
<b>Content-centered</b>	<b>Problem-centered</b>
<b>Standardized learning</b>	<b>Learning paced by ability/readiness</b>
<b>Little active participation</b>	<b>Active participation</b>
<b>Authoritative environment</b>	<b>Collaborative environment</b>
<b>Teacher responsible for planning</b>	<b>Shared responsibility for planning</b>
<b>Fear as motivator</b>	<b>Needs as motivator</b>
