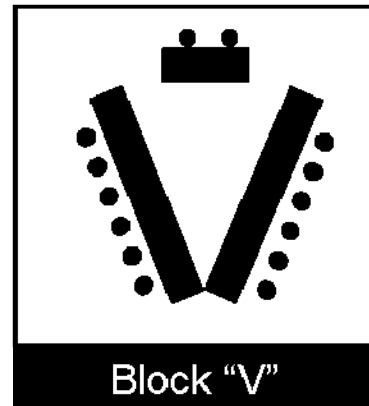
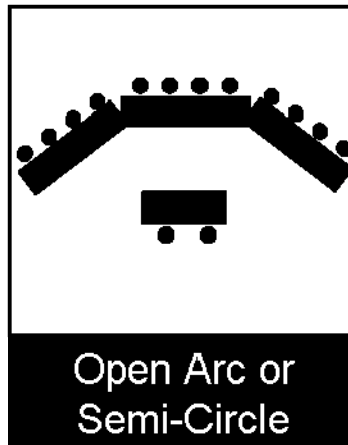
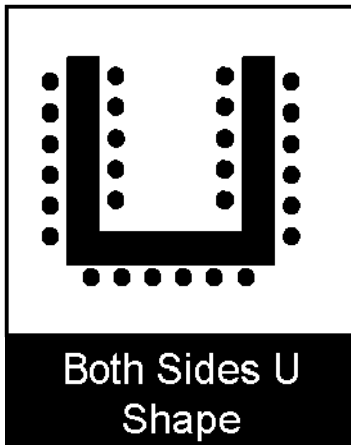
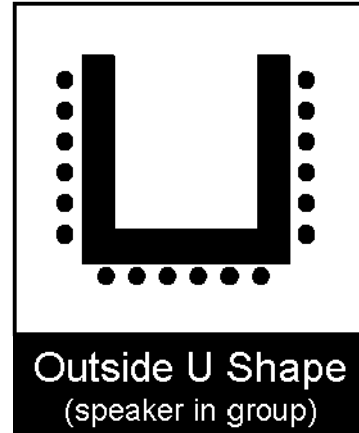
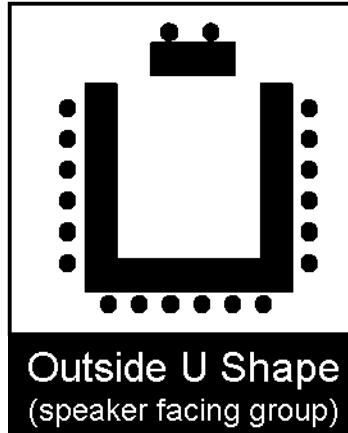
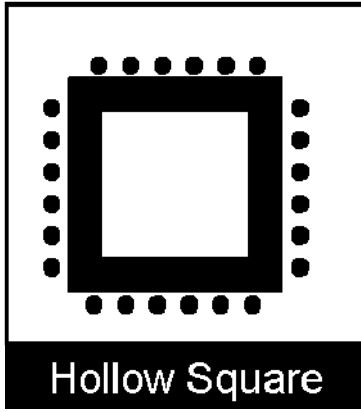
The room arrangement for a meeting or presentation should be intentionally planned and arranged. The arrangement of the room should be determined by:
