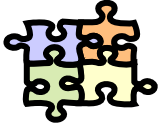


Filling Your Extension Toolkit: Review Activities



Reconstructing the Day

In this activity, the participants break into teams and reconstruct that day's main ideas, concepts, and terms for their assigned chunk of content. Each team uses one flipchart to "review" the concepts for the rest of the class. When the flipcharts are placed side by side, the content for that day should be represented.

There are several variations:

- All flipcharts can be posted and a silent "gallery walk" in which participants move among the flipcharts, reviewing them.
- Each flipchart can be posted and one of the team members remains with the flipchart to briefly review for each group of visitors. The length of the "visits" are timed; with a whistle announcing time for rotation.
- Each team can briefly review their key points and post their flipchart.
- Participants are invited to "add" to another team's flipchart.
- Flipcharts and markers
- Remember, you only have 15 minutes. So, quickly introduce the exercise and give instructions. Give an example.
- Encourage participants to use short, clear phrases. If a visual explains it better, use it.
- The facilitator needs to make summary comments, tying all the review together and transitioning to the next day.
