

POSTER ART CONTEST

- WHO:** The contest is open to all 4-H members ages 9-19.
- WHAT:** Posters should be 14" x 22" in dimension and may be horizontal or vertical. Posters may be any medium art – ink, crayon, acrylic, charcoal, colored pencil or collage.
- They cannot contain any copyrighted material such as cartoon characters and cannot have any three dimensional items on them.
- APPLICATION:** The 4-H member's name, age, county, full address and brief interpretation of art work must be affixed to the back of the poster in the upper left hand corner (a 3" x 5" index card may be used).
- AWARDS:** One poster per 4-H member will be accepted. Ten winners at the State Level will be selected and will receive a certificate, which will be presented at the District 4-H O-Rama's in June. The list of themes for each year will be announced in January.
- DEADLINE:** Posters must be correctly labeled on the back upper left corner and be in the State Communications office by the **first business day in May**. Submissions must be flat, not rolled.
