Dear Beef Cattle Producers:

This spring's Brucellosis Vaccination Clinic is scheduled for Monday, May 4. Heifer calves 4-12 months of age which have not been previously vaccinated are the targeted group. If interested, please return the enclosed card by Wednesday, April 29, to enroll. Be sure to completely fill out the card with the expected number of calves, a cell phone number that you can be reached on that day in case we are running behind or ahead of schedule, and the location of the cattle, including directions to your farm.

(You may also phone your response to us at 946-3231 or 673-2346.)

Please make a note on the card if you have a preferred time frame (such as morning or afternoon). We will do our best to accommodate you, although we do have to follow a general geographic order. Thank you for your past help in making Arkansas brucellosis free. We look forward to helping you make Arkansas even more competitive in the cattle industry.

With the Covid-19 pandemic we will be taking extra precautions while implementing this program. The current plan is for our vaccinator Brian Gibson and I to arrive in separate vehicles to your farm.
