## A Few Guidelines for Submitting Soil Samples:

- 1. Soil samples must be dry. We cannot ship wet samples to the soil testing lab.
- 2. Two cups of soil is needed for a good sample, and to maintain the integrity of the soil box during shipping.
- 3. If you have the boxes in which soil samples are submitted, please fill in your name and address legibly.
- 4. Provide your telephone number.
- 5. If submitting multiple samples, be sure to give each field a name you will recognize (8 character maximum).
- 6. Allow at least three weeks to receive the results of your soil test. Up to 6 weeks may be required in the early spring, due to the high volume of soil samples submitted to the soil testing laboratory during this busy time.
