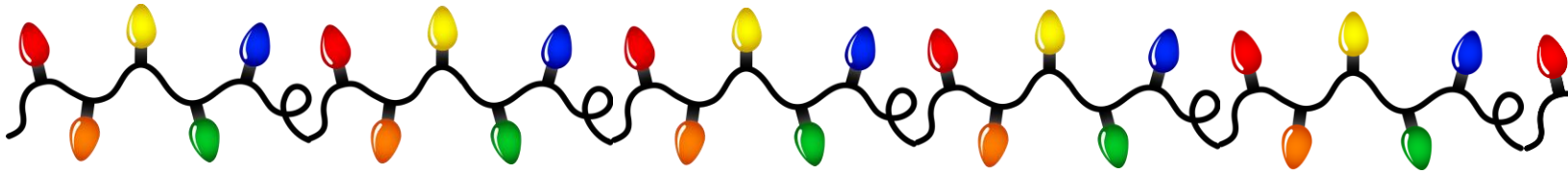

Teen Star Recognition Program

It's not too early to start looking at the Teen Star Applications! These can be found on the state website, or 4-H online. Don't wait until the last minute to fill these out. You will need to start working on them now, that way if there's something your missing you will still have time to complete it. With them available in 4-H online, you should be able to gradually work on the applications. In order to be a Teen Star, you must meet the following requirements:

- 14 years old as of January 1 of the current year.
- Should have completed one year as a 4-H member.
- Should be an active 4-H member at the time of application.
- Must display the following qualities:
 - Leadership ability
 - Integrity of character, demonstrating high moral standards and high goals.
 - Outstanding achievement in both project and service activities, ability to work with others, positive attitude, interest in the 4-H program, and a general interest in organizations and activities for youth development.

Teen Stars are recognized every year at the annual Teen Star Banquet held in June at the Teen Leader Conference in Ferndale. For questions about applying for Teen Star, or assistance with the application, contact Karla at the Extension Office. Completed applications are due by February 15th. You must first be named a Teen Star, then the following year, you can apply for State Ambassador.
