County Outdoor O’Rama

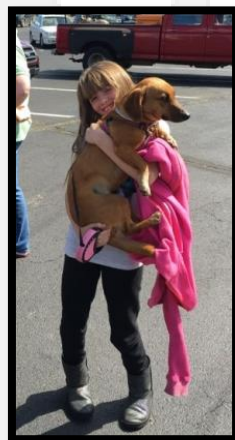

Quad County Camp

CSI: Crime Scene Investigation is this year's theme for Quad county Camp! Learn the science behind solving a mystery. We will have hands on activities like collecting evidence by fingerprints, footprints, hair, teeth impressions and so much more. We go to camps with 3 other counties so it is a great way to meet other 4-H members your age from other counties. Camp is open to 4-H members 9-19, but we only have a limited number of spots. It will be held June 15-17 at Timber Lodge Ranch near Amity. The first 10 campers to sign up and pay receive \$20 off of their camp fee of \$50. Applications are available at the Extension Office.

National Leadership Forum applications are due by May 23. This year's camp will take place June 1-6 at Harding University in Searcy. Through labs, lectures, films and discussion, participating youth will become more prepared and confident and equipped with the necessary tools to preserve the traditions and ideals upon which America was founded. A wide variety of speakers will present lectures and then allow for a question-and-answer periods and follow up labs.

Teen Challenge applications are due by May 30. The 41st-annual Teen Challenge camp will take place June 16-19 at the C. A. Vines Arkansas 4-H Center at Ferndale. Participants of this event will learn valuable leadership and team-building skills and will have outdoor recreation and plenty of challenge from the 4-H Center's Ropes Course.
