Sewing Day Camps – 9:00 am - 4:00 pm – Cost: \$20 each – Ages 8-18

A sewing machine will be needed but there are some available for loan on a first come basis. Mark on your registration form to reserve one. Supplies needed: fabric cutting scissors, short bladed scissors for snipping threads, straight pins, pin cushion, seam ripper, tape measure, hem gauge, hand sewing needles, pencil box type container for sewing supplies. Participants will need a sack lunch each day and each camp is limited to 16 participants.

Sewing I Day Camp – July 10-11 – For youth who are just beginning to sew.

Sewing II Day Camp – July 19-20 – For youth who have attended beginning sewing for 2 years or more or who have had some sewing experience in school or at home. This camp will build on the skills you have already learned.

Sewing III Day Camp – July 25-26 – For youth who have had 4 years of beginning sewing or who have attended advanced sewing before. We will learn on other types of sewing machines and equipment, but you will still need your regular sewing machine. If you have had sewing at school or learned at home and would be interested in intermediate or advanced sewing camp call the extension office and talk to Dianna.

Fun in the Kitchen Cooking Day Camp – June 12-13 or June 28-29 – 9:00 am - 2:00 pm – Cost: \$20 – Ages 8-18

This camp is two days of continuous cooking. We will prepare lunch each day as a part of the cooking experience. Each camp session will be limited to 16 participants. Camp participants will need to bring an apron to use in class. We will be preparing the same recipes at each camp session so only sign up for one Cooking Camp. Please let us know of any food allergies so we can plan the menu around those.

Shooting Sports Day Camp – Basic: June 18-19 – \$40 – Advanced: June 20 – \$30 (\$60 for Both) – 9:00am – 4:00pm

Basic: This day camp is designed to provide youth with an introduction to shooting sports. This 2 day camp will involve hands-on activities and classroom education. This camp is open to ages 5-19. Camp highlights are archery skills and games, BB rifle skills and games, and introduction to 4-H Shooting Sports. All equipment is provided.

Advanced: Youth must have completed the Basic Shooting Sports day camp and at least the 3rd grade to participate. This one day event will involve hands on demonstrations. Camp highlights are muzzleloaders, pellet pistols, and shotguns.

Sack lunch is needed every day. Both camps will be held at UAPB Farm located on Highway 31, North of Lonoke.

Mad Scientist Day Camp – Cloverbud (Ages 5-8): July 3 9:00am-1:00pm – Junior (Ages 9-13) June 26 9:00am-3:00pm - \$10

Participants will transform into Mad Scientists as they spend the day conducting hands-on experiments. Sack lunch needed.
