Each county may enter eight contestants, four juniors (ages 9-13) and four seniors (ages 14-19). Contestant shall furnish own grill, charcoal, lighter, sauce and other necessary equipment.

All contestants with grilling equipment will assemble at the site by 3:30 P.M., Contest will begin at 4:00 P.M. Each contestant will cook two (2) chicken breast filet. (Poultry will be furnished.)

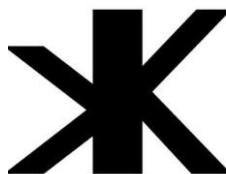
To register, let Stephany know ASAP as spots will fill up.
