Follow the link and then select “**Private Pesticide Applicator Training**”. You must still complete the paperwork (*Form DP-25*) and pay for your license (\$10 or \$45) through the Arkansas Department of Agriculture, Pesticides Section. For re-certifications, the license renewal form is mailed to you one month before your license expires. If you are re-certifying, after completing the online training, you will be eligible for either a 1 or 5-year private applicator license.
