Ashley	Terral REV 48A26	R1	Laid polypipe 6-10. Some morningglories emerged. Recommended 1 qt. Prefix + 6 oz. Flexstar. Initial irrigation early next week if no rain.
Chicot	Armor 46D08		Planted 6-12 at 146K seeds/acre. Applied 22 oz. RoundUp PowerMax + 5 oz. Verdict 6-13.
Clark	Pioneer P48A32X		Planted 6-11 at 140K seeds/acre. Applied 1 qt. generic glyphosate + 1.5 pt. Me-Too-Lachlor 6-12
Cross	Armor 48D24	V3	2" rain, Quickly outgrowing herbicide burn, good control of pigweeds. Applied 32oz glyphosate + 2pts prefix + 6oz Flexstar on 6/5.
Desha	Armor 48D24	R1	Received .6" rain. Finished herbicide application 6-10, worked well. Initial irrigation early next week if no rain.

Lawrence	Asgrow 46X6	R2	.60" rain, rapid growth over the past week. Starting to pick up low levels of green stinkbugs and mix of defoliators, field remain clean.
Lee	Pioneer P47T36R	V4	Received 2.3" rain. 1 qt. RoundUp PowerMax + 1 qt. Prefix + 10 oz. Section Three applied 6-11.
Lonoke	Bayer CZ 4918 LL	V1	Received 1.25" rain. Emerged 6-9 to stand of 115K plants/acre. Big flush of morningglories. Recommended 32 oz. generic glufosinate.
Miller	Merschman Miami 1949 LL	V2	Dryland. Received 1.35" rain. Didn't get sprayed last week but did this week with 36 oz. Liberty + 2 oz. Zidua.
Mississippi	Asgrow 46X6	VE	2" rain. Stand counts next week. Several late emerging beans needed rain to germinate, Good weed control from burndown.
Monroe	Progeny 5414 LL	VE-V1	Received 3.8" rain. Un-even emergence due to vegetation in some areas of the field that burndown didn't quite control. Hopefully stand counts next week.
Phillips	Stine 49LH02	V1	Dryland. Received 3" rain. Pretty thin stand, recommended replanting thin areas. Emerged pigweeds. Recommended 36 oz. Liberty.
Poinsett	Drewsoy 5.0		Planted 6/5 received 2.5" rain after drilling on 7.5" at 160K seed/acre, did not get adequate stand will need to be replanted.
Randolph	Asgrow 45X8		Planted 6/6 received 3" rain after planting on 30" beds at 140K seed/acre, did not get adequate stand will need to be replanted
