General	By Chad Norton and Chris Elkins. Rain from Barry varied significantly across locations but all fields received rain. The Arkansas county 2 field led the pack with 9.3", while the Clark county field was not accessible due to flood water. The rain benefited several fields and delayed irrigations. Insect pressure continues to remain low but is expected increase. Disease pressure has been minimal so far this year. Refer to table below for field specific information.

Jefferson	Pioneer P43A42X	R2	Received 5.7" rain Very clean and rapidly growing. Insect and disease free.	
Lawrence	Asgrow 46X6	R4	Received 1.85" rain. Looks good, blooming on last node, Lower canopy starting fill pods, Stinkbugs 2/25.	
Lee	Pioneer P47T36R	R2	Received 5.5" rain. Very clean good looking field. Stinkbugs running 3/25 sweeps. Disease free.	
Lonoke	Bayer CZ 4918 LL	R2	Received 3.7" rain. Morningglories emerged, Insect and disease free.	
Miller	Merschman Miami 1949 LL	R2	Dryland. Received .3" rain. Started blooming with a vengeance. If we keep getting rains it could be very good for dryland.	
Mississippi	Asgrow 46X6	R1	Received 4.6" rain. Looks good, very clean. Insect and disease free.
