As predicted, corn earworms have become an issue as four fields reached treatment thresholds. Stink bugs are slowly building. Diseases have yet to cause problems. Arkansas	Pioneer P45A29L	R5	Third irrigation should be soon, might get to the end with one additional irrigation. Stink bugs remain 1/25 sweeps, going to have to hurry to become a problem. Disease free.
Ashley	Terral REV 48A26	R5	Third irrigation applied 8-8, fourth 8-15 if no rain. Very clean.
Chicot	Armor 46D08	R2	Initial irrigation applied 8-4, second 8-16 if no rain. 1.5 oz. Heligen + 1% COC applied 8-3 for corn earworms.
Clark	Pioneer P48A32X	R2	Initial irrigation applied 7-31, second should be soon. 1.28 oz. Heligen + 1% COC applied 8-3 for corn earworms.
Cross	Armor 48D24	R4	Received .5" rain. Looks good, 1/25 corn earworms, low disease pressure, Second irrigation scheduled for 8/7.
Desha	Armor 48D24	R5	Second irrigation applied 8-6, third 8-18 if no rain. Stink bugs running 1/25 sweeps, should get by without treating. Disease free.
Greene	Stine 49LD02	R2	Received .85" rain. Remains clean, only able to apply 1.4" during irrigation not soaking as it should, Initial irrigation 8/4. Second Irrigation 8/12,
Jackson - 1	UA 5414RR	R2	No rain. 1/25 corn earworm, Low disease pressure. Initial irrigation scheduled for 8/6. Levees pulled and ready to water.
Jackson - 2	Pioneer 47A76L	R5	No rain. Excellent potential, Low insect and disease pressure. Initial Irrigation 8/4. Second irrigation scheduled for 8/15.
Jefferson	Pioneer P43A42X	R5	Third irrigation applied 8-2, fourth 8-12 if no rain. Stink bugs running 4/25 sweeps. Disease free.
Lawrence	Asgrow 46X6	R5	Received .4" rain. Mid R5, quickly filling pods, 3/25 stinkbugs, Fourth irrigation 8/7, fifth irrigation scheduled for 8/16.
Lee	Pioneer P47T36R	R5	Second irrigation applied 8-6, third 8-13 if no rain. Stinkbugs running 2/25 sweeps, might get by them. Disease free. Getting a little rank.
Lonoke	Bayer CZ 4918 LL	R4	Third irrigation should be soon. Stink bugs running 2/25 sweeps. Disease free.
Miller	Merschman Miami 1949 LL	R4	Dryland. Received .35" rain, needs to keep coming. Now running a moisture deficit of 6.04". Red banded stink bugs and corn earworms running 2/25 sweeps.
Mississippi	Asgrow 46X6	R3	Received .1" rain. Looks good, almost canopy, clean. Insect and disease pressure remain low. Initial irrigation 7/31. Second irrigation scheduled for 8/11.
Monroe	Progeny 5414 LL	R3	Second irrigation should be soon. Stink bugs running 4/25 sweeps. Disease free.
Phillips	Stine 49LH02	R2	Dryland. Soil moisture deficit of 3.61". Recommended 1.28 oz. Heligen + 1% COC for corn earworms. Disease free.
Poinsett	Drewsoy 5.0	R2	Received no rain. Good growth, several small earworms average 3/25, recommend 1.28oz/ac Heligen. Initial irrigation scheduled for 8/7, levees pulled.

White	Terral REV 47L38	R3	Received no rain, erratic growth from deer feeding and water holes, disease pressure low. Initial irrigation 7/31. Second irrigation scheduled for 8/8
Woodruff	Stine 51LI32	R2	Received no rain. Good growth, 8/2 applied 40oz Cheetah + 8oz Clethodim 2E, good weed control, Initial irrigation scheduled for 8/6.
