

Rice Research Verification Program Update – Aug 23, 2019

General:	<p>By Ralph Mazzanti and Ron Baker:</p> <p>In the south, The Jefferson County field has been harvested. Several fields are draining. The Desha County field reached threshold on rice stink bugs (RSB). Disease pressure continues to be a non-issue in late rice.</p> <p>In the north, Randolph is mature and drying to harvest moisture. Lawrence is drained with Jackson and Woodruff soon to follow. Craighead (furrow irrigated) continues to have extremely low RSB counts but grain heads blanked by billbugs are being observed scattered across the field.</p>

Arkansas	Diamond	70% HD	RSB averaging 2 per 10 sweeps. The field is ready to drain.
Chicot	RT Gemini 214 CL	Mature	Ready for harvest.
Craighead	RT XP753	40% H D	RSB averaging .2 per 10 sweeps. Field continues to progress well.
Crittenden	Diamond	5% HD	RSB averaging 4.7 per 10 sweeps. Field continues to progress well.
Desha	CL XL 745	100% Heading	RSB averaged 7 per 10 sweeps and Lambda-Cy was recommended at 1.8 oz.
Jackson	Diamond	70% H D	Field is ready to drain.
Jefferson	Diamond	Harveste d	Harvested 8/20. Yield 180 bu/ac. Harvest moisture 18.4%.
Lawrence	RT XP753	70% H D	Field is drained and maturing for harvest. .
Lee	Diamond	20% HD	RSB averaging 2 per 10 sweeps.
Lincoln	RT Gemini 214 CL	Late Boot	Water level continues low to muddy in places struggling to get water which gravity flows from adjacent field.
Lonoke	RT XP753	60% HD	Field is draining.
Monroe	RT XP753	20-60% HD	RSB averaging 5 per 10 sweeps. Field maturity will not be uniform delay on draining.
Randolph	RT CLXP4534	Mature	Ready for harvest.
White	RT XP753	5% HD	RSB averaging .7 per 10 sweeps. Field continues to progress well.
Woodruff	Diamond	65% H D	Irrigation terminated. Drain date 8/26.
