

**Rice Research Verification Program Update – June 28, 2019**

<b>General:</b>	By Ralph Mazzanti and Ron Baker:		
	<p>In the south, Jefferson is beyond 2<sup>nd</sup> IE stage. Chicot and Arkansas are at early internode elongation stage. Lonoke, Lee and Monroe Counties are moving close to green ring. The Desha and Lincoln County fields are at the 1<sup>st</sup> tiller stage.</p> <p>In the north, fields are progressing quickly with Randolph being the first to reach green ring. Several fields will need nitrogen scans with GreenSeeker within a few days. Most fields are performing really well. However, Lawrence exhibited nitrogen depletion in streaks across the field prior to green ring prompting a corrective application of urea.</p>

Arkansas	Diamond	IE	Field is clean, progressing well at IE stage.
Chicot	RT Gemini 214 CL	IE	The field is clean, received 3.5” rainfall. Maturity has slowed due to cloudy overcast and cool weather.
Craighead	RT XP753	4 <sup>th</sup> Tiller	2 <sup>nd</sup> application of 180 lbs urea + NBPT made and incorporated by 0.82 inches rainfall. Weed control is good.
Crittenden	Diamond	3 <sup>rd</sup> Tiller	Field is flooded and progressing normally. Weed control is good.
Desha	CL XL 745	1 <sup>st</sup> Tiller	Field received 3.7” rainfall. Barnyardgrass has exploded. Regiment .63 oz + Ricestar HT 24 oz + Triple Play 12.8 oz 300 lbs Urea + NBPT and flood.
Jackson		4 <sup>th</sup> Tiller	Field is flooded and progressing normally. Weed control is good.
Jefferson	Diamond	IE	Field is clean with an adequate flood.
Lawrence	RT XP753	4 <sup>th</sup> Tiller	Field has responded well to 100 lb. corrective urea application. Weed control is good except for edges of the field difficult to spray by air.
Lee	Diamond	4 <sup>th</sup> Tiller	Field received 1.3” rainfall progressing well with adequate flood. Levees were sprayed for pigweeds.
Lincoln	RT Gemini 214 CL	1 <sup>st</sup> Tiller	Field received 3.6” rainfall. Grasses are at 3-4 leaf stage RiceBeaux 4 qts. + Facet 32 oz.
Lonoke	RT XP753	4 <sup>th</sup> Tiller	Field is clean with MIRI and good flood.
Monroe	RT XP753	4 <sup>th</sup> Tiller	Rainfall 1.8” Due to plane streaking will live with some grass escapes.
Randolph	RT CLXP4534	Early IE	Field is flooded and progressing normally. Weed control is good.
White	RT XP753	2 <sup>nd</sup> Tiller	Applied 3 qts. RiceBeaux; Applied 240 lbs urea + NBPT; permanent flood scheduled.
Woodruff	Diamond	4 <sup>th</sup> Tiller	Field is flooded and progressing normally. Weed control is good. Corrective Note: Pre-flood urea was 240 lbs. (aprox. 110 lbs N)
