Table 1 presents USDA Farm Service Agency’s certified Arkansas wheat planted acreage by NASS district. In 2013, wheat was planted on 596,307 acres in the state. The leading two districts are District 6 and District 3, with 303,650 and 145,871 total acres planted, respectively. These two districts are located in the Delta region, and represent nearly 75% of planted acreage in 2013.

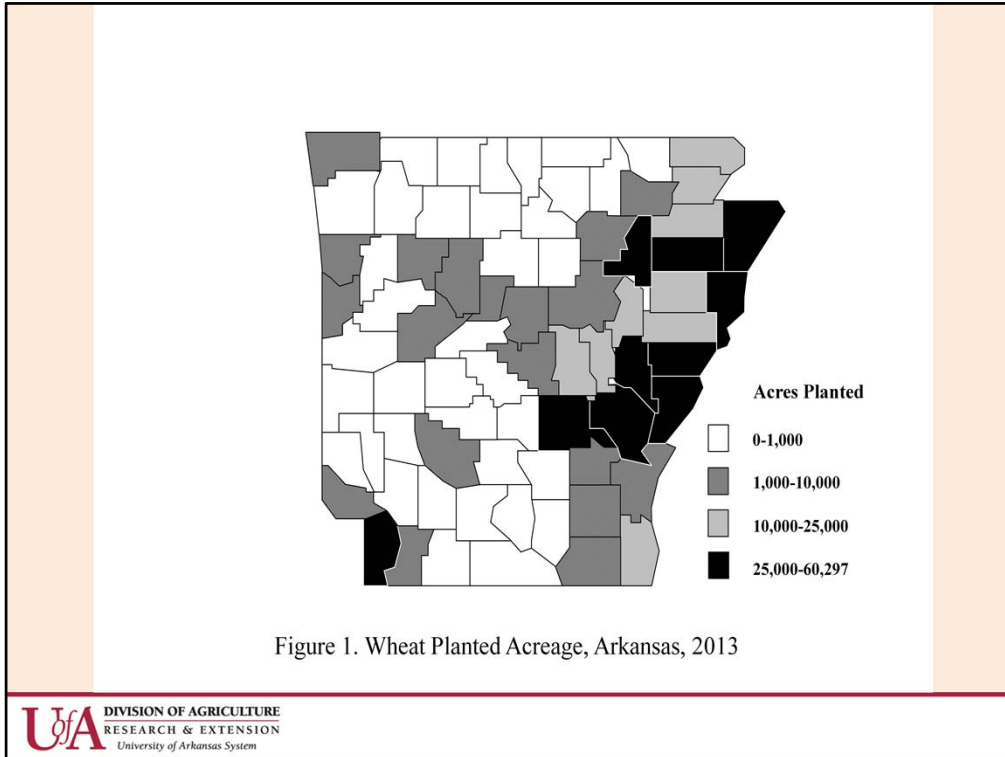


Figure 1 presents wheat planted acreage categories for Arkansas counties.

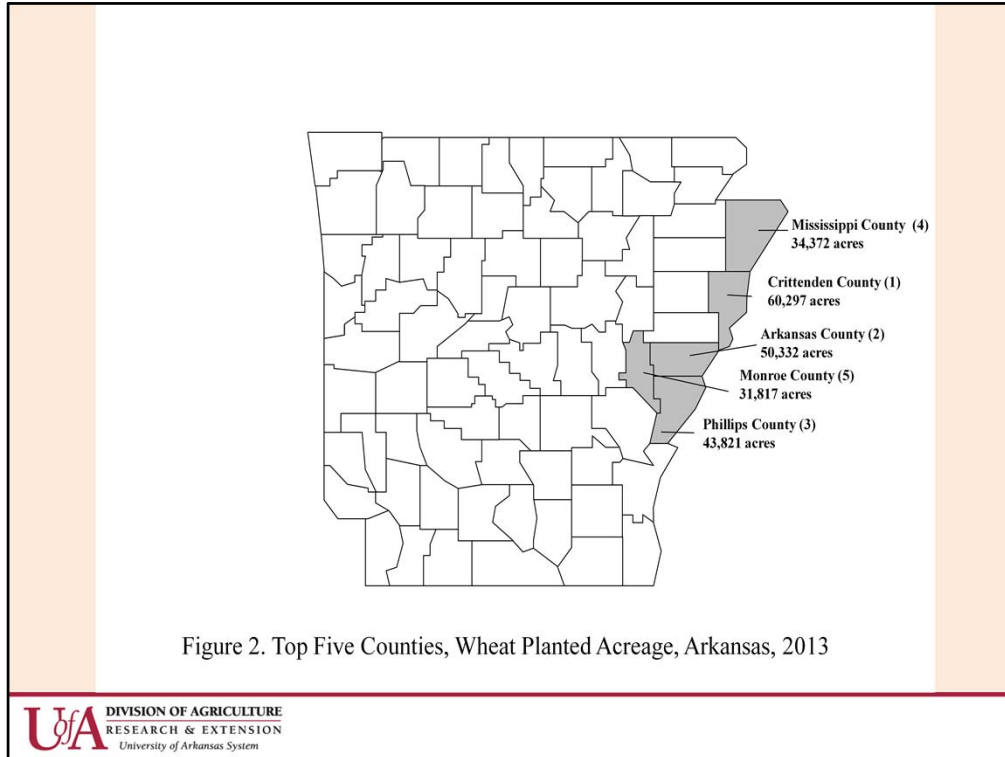


Figure 2 presents the top five counties in planted wheat acreage. Crittenden and Lee counties led the state in wheat acreage planted, with 60,297 and 50,332 acres planted, respectively. The counties of Phillips, Mississippi, and Monroe complete the top five counties in acreage planted. These five counties represented approximately 37% of total wheat acreage planted in 2013.

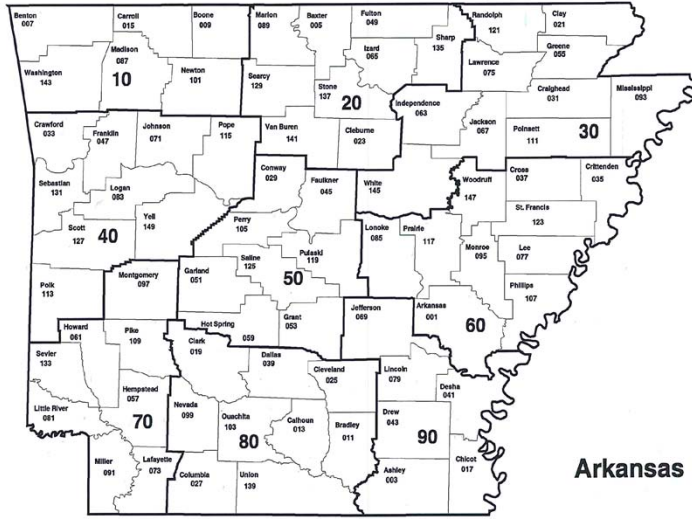
