

Temperature Requirements of Selected House Plants

Cool Temperature Plants are those that grow best at a 50 to 60 degrees Fahrenheit during the day and at 45 to 55 degrees Fahrenheit at night.

Medium Temperature Plants are those that grow best at 60 to 65 degrees Fahrenheit during the day and at 55 to 60 degrees Fahrenheit at night.
